What's new in this version

New functionality in the share widget enables you to share the layers that are currently visible in the map. Please note though there is a limitation to how many layers you can have turned on otherwise the url will be too long to generate and will error. See the <u>help article</u> from Esri for more information about using this widget.

The swipe widget has been added which enables you to easily compare the content of different layers in a map. You can slide the swipe tool to reveal the content of another layer. For example, you may want to use it to show before-and-after imagery of a flood, or display two related thematic layers in a map. See the user <u>help article</u> for more information about this widget.

We have also added the Coordinate Conversion widget which enables users to input coordinates using one coordinate system and output to a different coordinate system using multiple notation formats. For more information about this widget and how to use see the <u>help article</u>.

Basemap gallery, draw and measure widgets

The basemap gallery widget allows you to toggle between different basemaps. Please note you will need to turn off the Locate imagery layer to view the basemap.





The draw widget allows you to draw on the map and customise the style, colours and other features.

The measure widget allows you to measure lines or areas.









Printing



Using the print widget you can customise a map including layers you have turned on and create a pdf (or other format) to print out a hard copy.



Add Data and Share



You can add other services from various formats. Once you have copied in the URL click add then navigate back to the layer list widget and the service added will now appear at the top of the list.

You can share the app via email, Facebook, Twitter and Google+. In the sharing options you can customise a marker and there is also the ability to save the layers visible when you share. Please note if you have too many layers on when sharing it will error (this is a limitation of Esri that you can only share limited layers). You can also embed the app in a website by copying the HTML code and pasting into your website.

Coordinates and location



In the bottom left corner of the map are some widgets to help with location and coordinates. The + and – are to zoom in and out. The house icon is to return to the default extent. There is also a My Location widget that will zoom to your location that it detects from your computer or mobile device (works best on mobile devices as some computers may be set to a different server location). The full screen widget allows you to extend the map to your screen. The scale bar is set in meters to help you measure a distance.



The coordinate widget allows you to choose between different coordinate systems. Web Mercator is displayed by default when you move your mouse around the map. To select GDA 94 you will need to select this coordinate system then click somewhere on the map to add a point and the coordinates will display.

The coordinate conversion widget allows you to select an input coordinate system and see the output coordinate systems for a particular point on the map.







Swipe layers

The Swipe widget enables you to easily compare the content of different layers in a map. It provides a vertical mode to slide the swipe tool around to reveal the content of another layer. For example, you may want to use it to show current and historical imagery of a townsite or display two related thematic layers in a map.
